- Each month your library will mail you a postcard with developmental milestones your child experiences from birth to age 3.
- Keep an eye out during your child's birthday month these first three years – the library will be mailing them a special birthday present, too!



1000 Books Before Kindergarten

1. Visit any Warren County Public Library location and ask staff for a 1000 Books Before Kindergarten first-100 log sheet or access via our website.
2. Keep track of each book that is read to your child by you or any other caregiver they spend time with on the log sheet.
3. After logging your first set of 100 books, visit one of the library locations listed above to receive a board book and the next milestone bookmark (or download the next one).
4. When you read 100 more books together, bring in the completed log to receive a small milestone prize and the next bookmark.
5. Upon completion of all 1,000 books, your child will receive a special medal, a gift certificate for a free book from Capitol Books, and a certificate of completion!
